**NJSCIS programs** are offered for a semester, a summer, or for a full academic year in over forty countries. You can choose to enroll in language courses, general education courses, or in some cases major courses overseas with approval from your academic department. **Faculty short-term programs** are offered every summer led by faculty from William Paterson University. They are five weeks in length on average and have included trips to Western Europe, Africa, Asia, and South America. Past programs have concentrated on language (which can be done as an alternative to courses on campus or include upper-level coursework), art, business, and social science. **Eligibility requirements** include that you must be a full-time undergraduate student of at least sophomore-standing with a GPA of 2.5 minimum (some programs require at least a 3.0). University policy requires that the last thirty credits of your program must be completed at William Paterson. Please contact us for additional requirements, for instructions on how to apply and for additional information.

The **due date** for most Summer and Fall applications through NJSCIS is **March 1<sup>st</sup>**; most Spring applications are due **October 1<sup>st</sup>**.
