The Women of Vision Awards

William Paterson University began *The Women of Vision Awards* in 2006 as a way to recognize women in our community during our annual Women's History Celebration. For the past eight years, the award has honored outstanding women from the following five nomination categories: student, alumni, faculty, staff/administrator, and community.

Nominees for the *Women of Vision Awards* should exemplify most of the following criteria:

- Commitment to education and lifelong learning
- Outstanding personal qualities such as caring, initiative, thoughtfulness
- Concern for others and the highest good of the community
- Dedication to the expansion of opportunities for others, particularly women
- Vision, voice, and leadership that impacts lives and the welfare of the community

Nominations will be considered regardless of race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, age, marital status, familial status, affectional or sexual orientation. Our award is open to women in all fields and endeavors, at any stage of their career.

The award is presented at the Women's History Celebration Closing Ceremony, *The Red Dress Dinner*, to be held this year on **Wednesday, March 26, 2014 beginning at 5 pm** in the University Commons Ballrooms at William Paterson University. Awardees are expected to attend the closing ceremony.
