Strategic Plan Goals: Goal IV.C

- “Update the University’s current facilities master plan to ensure that the campus is **welcoming and fully modernized**. (*Ben Shahn, Wightman*)
- “Address the University’s needs for additional **smart classrooms, student common space and offices**.” **Complete in 2018 – more classrooms (14 with 243 more seats), more common spaces, more offices (48)**.
- “Utilize a **traffic study** begun in Fall 2011 to analyze traffic patterns to determine if a redesign of major access points and internal drives” (**No current initiatives**)
- “Modernize existing **residence halls** and possible construction of additional residences.” (**New residence hall design underway, but \$ will be needed for Overlook South and others**).
- “Design all construction and renovation projects to be **environmentally sound**, use at least a significant proportion of recycled materials in such projects and ensure maximum energy-efficiency in campus buildings.”
- “Seek to reduce costs and enhance the campus experience of faculty, staff, students and visitors through a continuous, on-going program of **productivity increases**.”

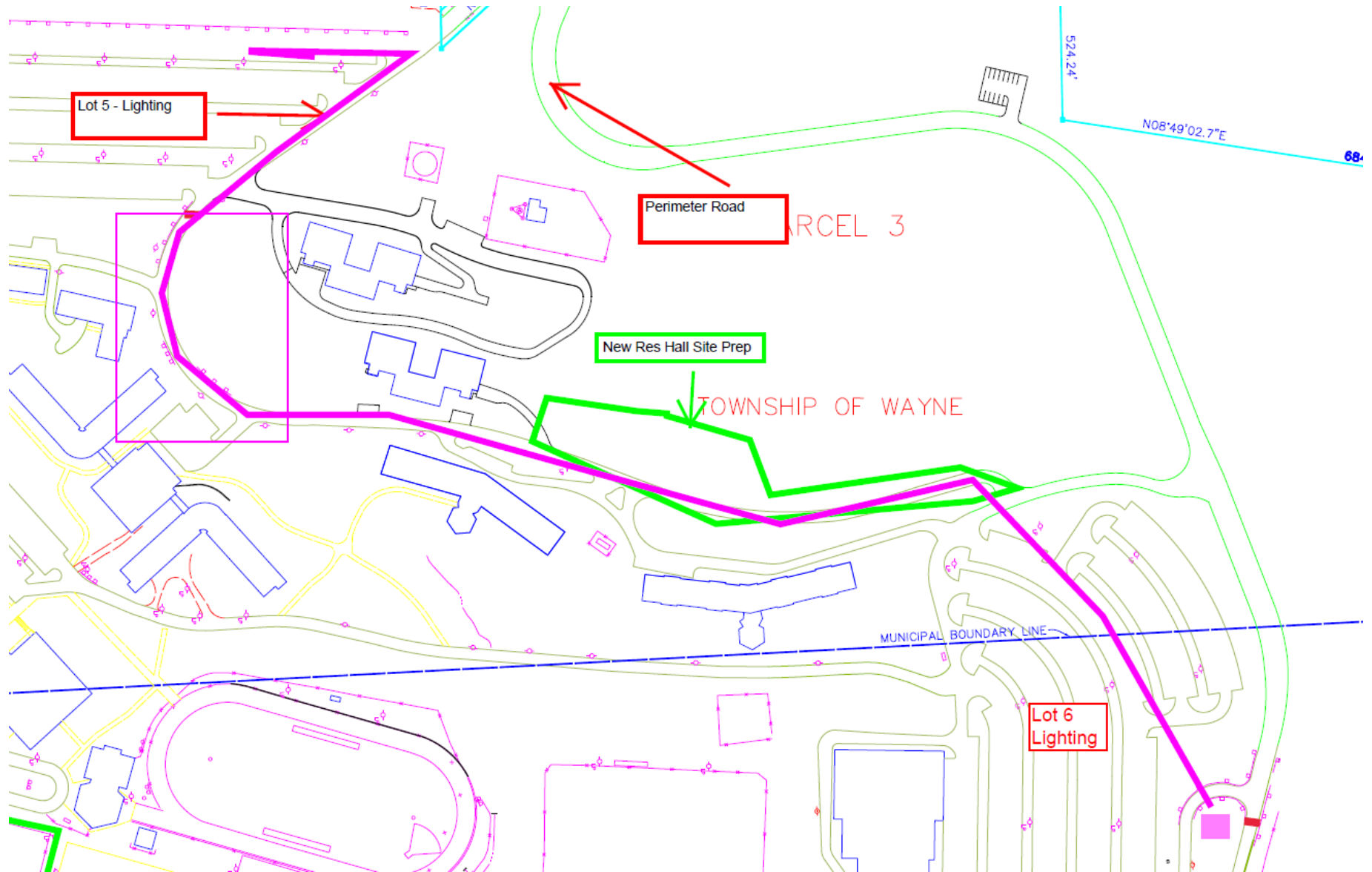

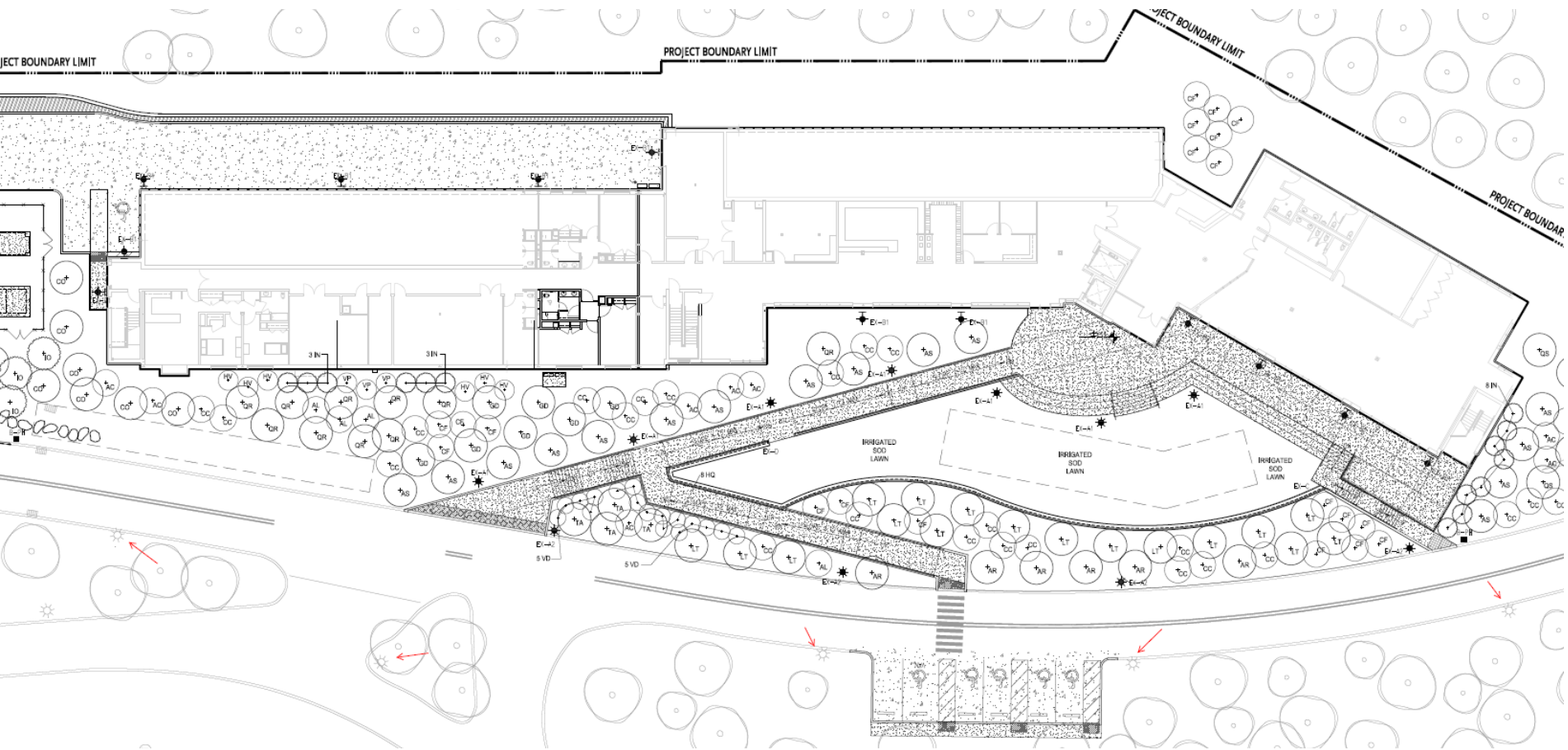
