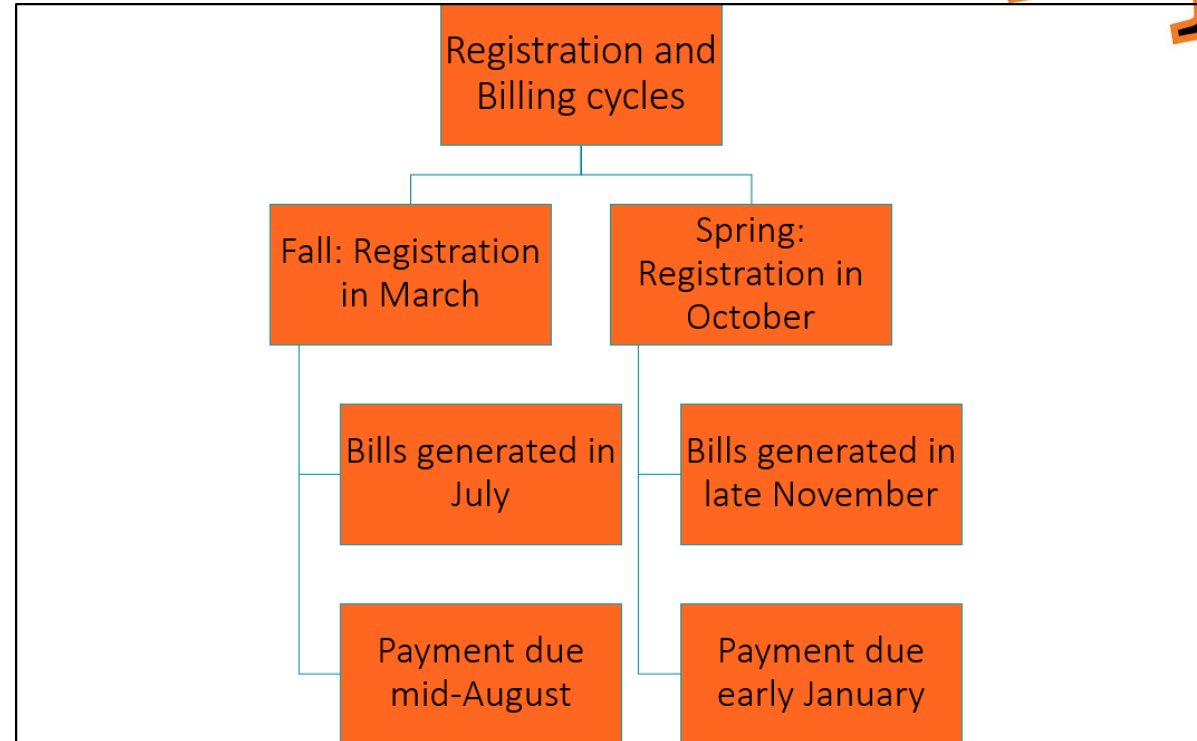
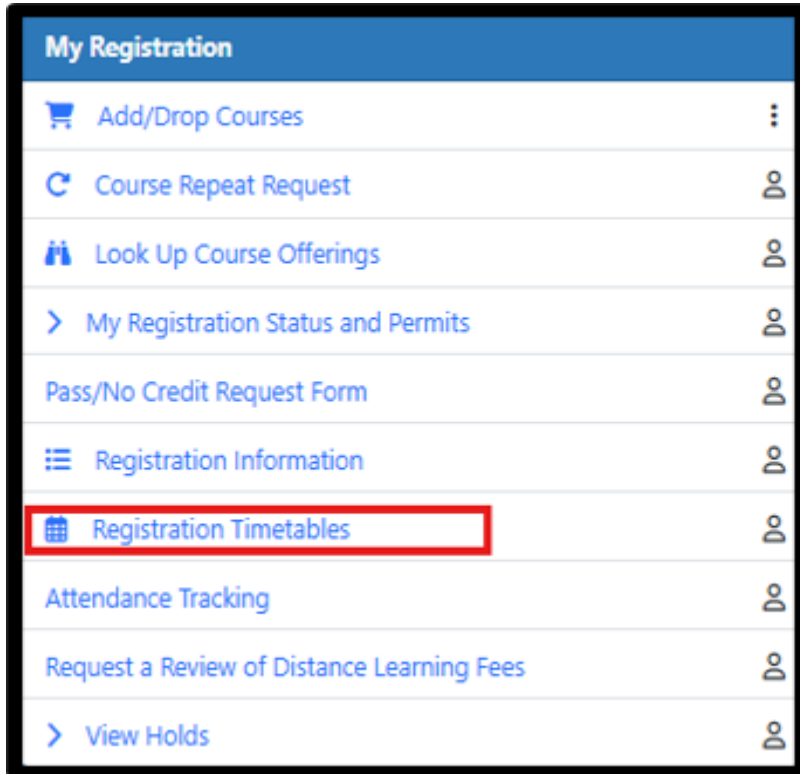

Understanding Registration Cycle

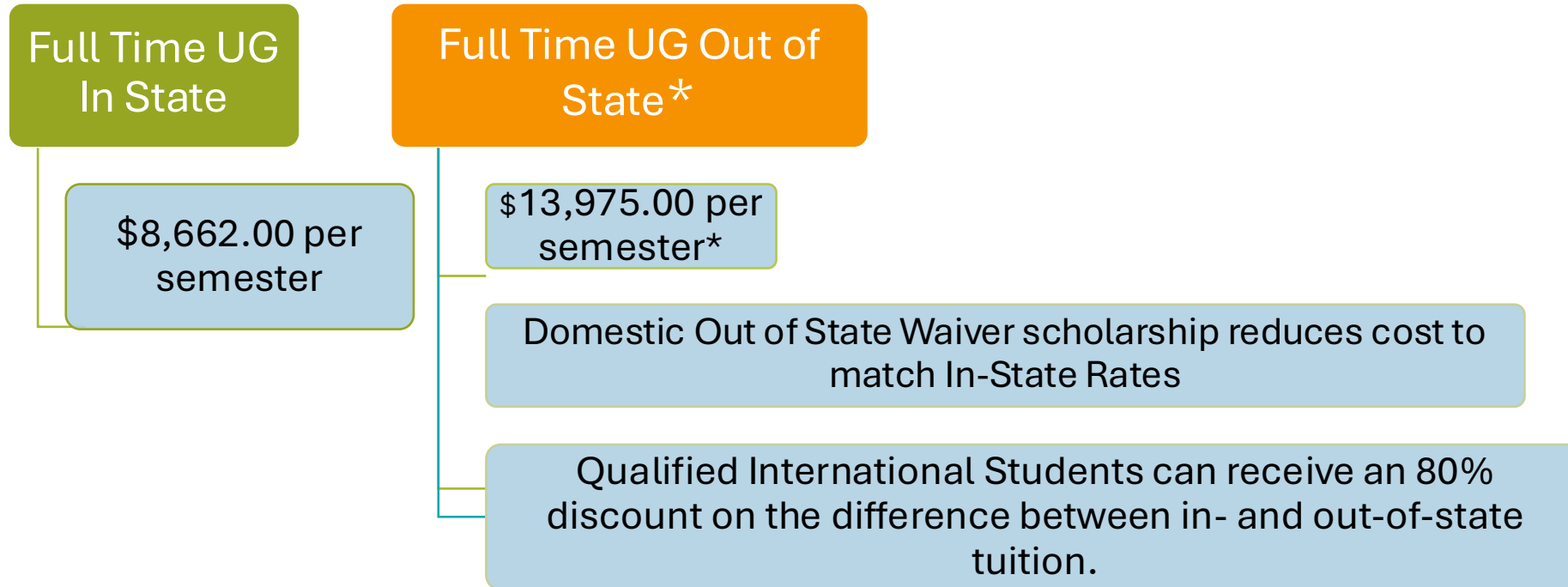

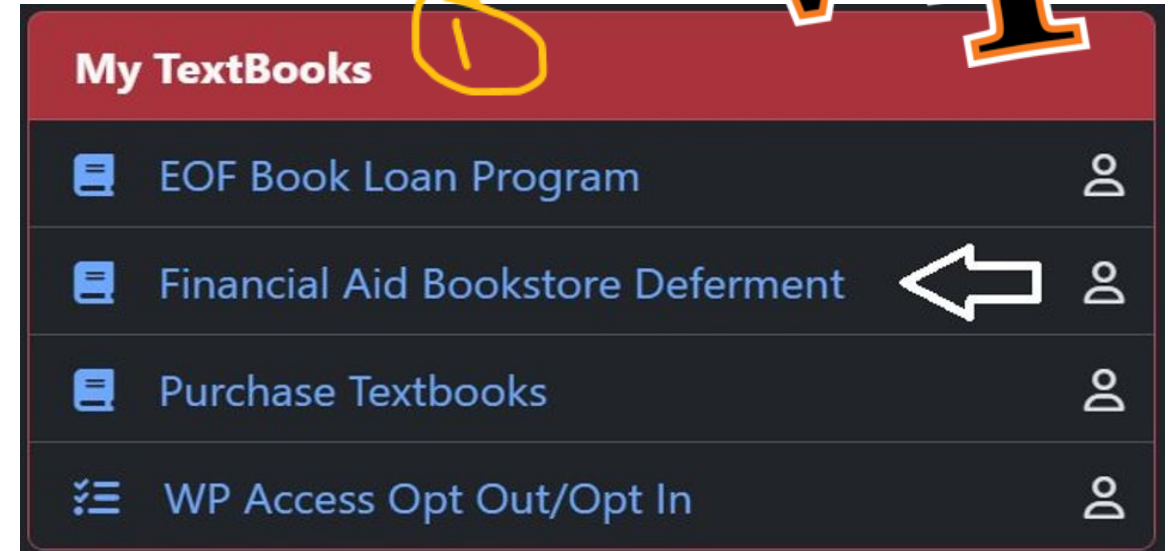

Book Store Deferments: Valid for accounts with Credit Balance- Pending Financial Aid Disbursement



- Allows students to use excess financial aid funds to purchase books & supplies
- Must have a credit balance in the current semester: after all semester charges are paid in full
- Must have all financial aid requirements completed
- Complete the Financial Aid Title IV authorization form to authorize (accept) the payment of “Non-inst charges with Title IV” with credit balance.
- Complete the Application via WPCConnect



Authorized Users/FERPA

Students can authorize a parent or third party to their Billing/Payment Portal

Authorized users receive their own access to view:

- 1098T tax statements
- E-statements and make payments
- Enroll in TIP plans

Does not provide access to grades or other confidential information

If authorized user calls or emails with questions, FERPA authorization is required

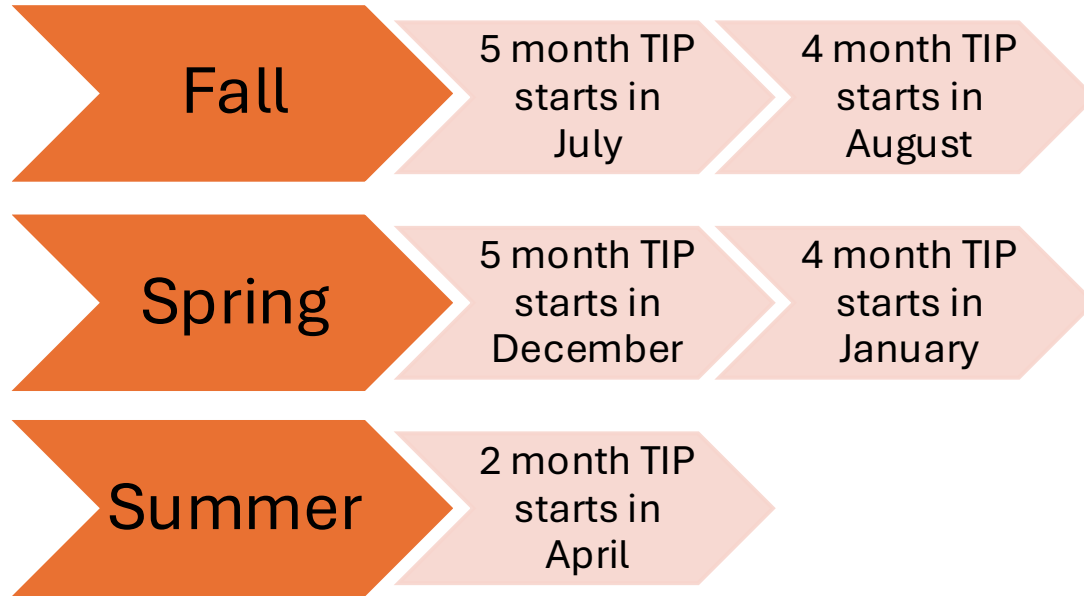
529 College Savings Plan:

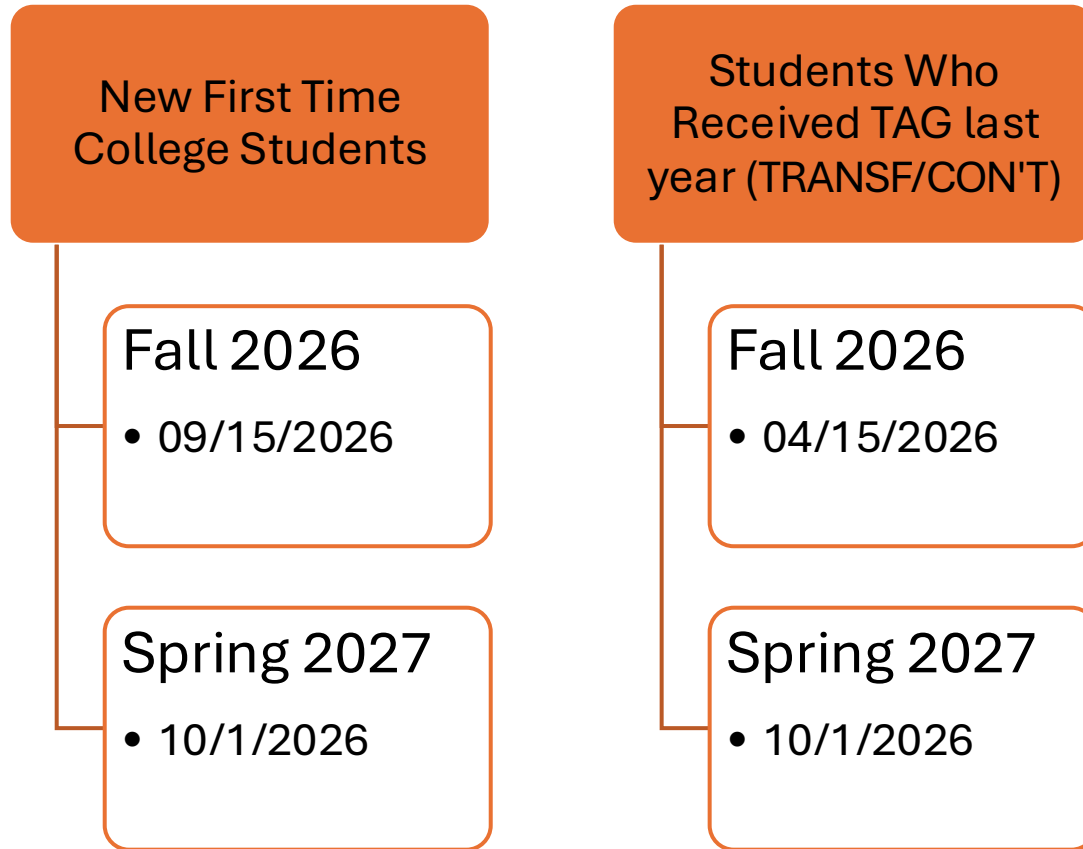

Enrollment Credits & Impact on Financial Aid

Attendance:

- No Attendance impacts federal aid eligibility
- Missing or withdrawing from courses can reduce or cancel aid

If student enrolls less than 12 credits in fall or spring:

- No NJ TAG
 - In addition, no summer Part Time TAG
- Pell is prorated or cancelled depending on SAI (index on FAFSA)
- No WP Pledge for Success or Garden State Guarantee Gap funding
- No Merit Scholarships
- No Out of State Tuition Schlp Waiver



SAP Requirement For Continued Financial Aid

SAP = Satisfactory Academic Progress

To be eligible for federal and state aid funds a student must be making satisfactory academic progress.

Three criteria used for evaluating SAP (UG Students):

1. Grade Point Average – GPA: 2.0 or better GPA required
2. Completion Rate: Must complete 67% of attempted credits
3. Maximum Credits Attempted – Maximum Time Frame 150% of degree credits required for degree =maximum of 180 credits

WHAT DOES TUITION INSURANCE COVER?

Covered reasons

Our plans provide peace of mind by reimbursing the financial losses if a student withdraws at any time during the semester for a covered reason as advised by a licensed medical professional for the covered term, which can include:

-  **Covered serious injury or illness**
Such as mononucleosis or a severe head injury.
-  **Chronic illness**
Such as an auto-immune disorder or diabetes.
-  **Mental health conditions**
Such as stress, depression, or severe anxiety.
-  **Death of a tuition payer**
Such as a parent or guardian.
-  **Loss of employment of a tuition payer**
Students who are forced to withdraw from school due to a covered involuntary loss of employment of a tuition payer can now be reimbursed for their tuition, fees, and room and board. This new benefit is only available on GradGuard's Active Choice plan, which can be purchased through a partner school.
