Eligibility:

- Student writing must be submitted by a faculty member, full- or part-time
- Previously published writing is not eligible
- Entries must have been produced for an undergraduate course at WPU between Summer 2016 and Spring 2017.

Application must include:

- (1) completed contest entry form (see below)
- (2) electronic copy of written piece being submitted
- (3) assignment description or instructions
- (4) permission from the student (on application form or via email)
