Review of the UCC Area SLOs

- Area 5 Community and Civic Engagement – approved
- Area 6 Global awareness – approved
- It was recommended and accepted that the UCC webpage will post the ten UCC Program SLO
- Outcomes for Technology Intensive Course – approved
- Outcomes for Writing Intensive Course – extended discussion on whether the UCC Council can get an approved version before the Writing Intensive Workshop; the UCC will meet on 3/25 to review the draft of the guidelines.
- It was recommended that the following be added to a future agenda: a discussion of how to judge the rigor of a course

UCC Criteria

- Students cannot take one course to meet two areas, such as Global Awareness and Diversity and Justice, even if the course was approved for both areas
- Requirement that students must take 21 credits in areas 1-3 plus a course in area 4 before taking courses in Areas 5 &6 – approved
