Please join us for a three day hands-on, interactive learning institute on the lesson study process, planning research lessons, and observing and discussing research lessons. Participants also will learn how to conduct *kyozaikenkyu* (instructional material investigation) that is important to improve teachers' content and pedagogical knowledge as well as improve their learning process through lesson study. Participants will develop research lessons, and these lessons will then be implemented from September through November 2011 in classrooms with students. All participants will meet again in early December for presentation reviews and discussions of the research lessons. Additional event details will be posted online soon.

Lesson study is recognized by the National Staff Development Council as one of the most powerful designs for building professional learning communities. Teachers engage in lesson study to systematically examine instructional methods, content, curriculum, and student learning/understanding. in order to improve classroom teaching and learning, and achieve their educational goals.
