Recommendations for Parents

The safety of your child and your child's possessions is important. To help insure your child's safety and the safety of your child's possessions, the following recommendations are suggested:

- 1. Record the serial numbers contained on your child's property;
- 2. Encourage your child to sign up for Connect-Ed, which is our emergency communication system;
- 3. Place emergency telephone numbers on your child's cellular telephone;
- 4. Know the names and telephone numbers of at least three of your child's friends on campus in addition to the name and telephone number of room and suite mates;
- 5. Record your child's class schedule;
- 6. Obtain a locking device for your child's computer if it will be left unattended;
- 7. Obtain a locked box for your child's valuables and money;
- 8. Encourage your child to check all financial records to insure that no one else is using
- 9. your child's accounts;
- 10. Place the campus emergency numbers in a place accessible to you in case of an
- 11. emergency; and
- 12. Talk to your child about the consequences of leaving valuable property unattended.
