## Minutes February 1, 2010

Meeting called to order by Chair, K. Martus at 2:10

- 1. Martus distributed the agenda which was moved by Sgro and seconded by Bambrick. The agenda was unanimously approved.
- 2. Approval of the minutes from the December 7, 2009 meeting was moved by Betts seconded by Smith. They were unanimously approved.
- 3. Research & Scholarship Day, 2010

After a discussion the council agreed that *Writing Across the Curriculum* students should not be held with the Library's Authors Reception and should be a separate event during UR&S Day.

Bambrick reported that large signs will need to be posted outside the student center earlier than 1 week before the event. Martus will send out an e-mail to council members for help with posting of R&S Day signs in strategic places; including Power Arts building, Valley Road campus & main campus.

Bastas will work on obtaining a certificate of recognition signed by the Provost or President for presentation to the student that won the R & S Day poster contest. This certificate can be presented at the Author's Recognition. An will e-mail Bastas the students name.

Bambrick motioned and Smith seconded that University Research and Scholarship Day should be included in the Council's standing charges. The motion passed unanimously.

4. Research & Scholarship Day, 2011

The council agreed on April 7, 2011 for the next R&S Day. Bambrick will work on reserving the rooms.

- 5. Martus introduced that the council's name be changed from Research Council to "Research and Scholarship Council". Bambrick motioned for the name change seconded by Smith. All members unanimously agreed.

The success of this database will depend solely on the faculty and staff providing the searchable keywords.
