Turnitin/Blackboard Integration

Turnitin (née Turn-it-in.com) is a plagiarism detector that allows faculty compare student papers with a bank of over 150 million archived student papers and close to 100,000 journals, periodicals and books. Now integrated with Blackboard (Bb) it is a powerful tool for uncovering plagiarism. Faculty can use it one of two ways:

- 1. Direct students to use the Blackboard interface to submit papers directly to Tii. Instructors will receive a report on each paper, gauging the overall level of originality and highlighting the instances of copied text as well as the original source of the material.
- 2. Faculty can submit only those papers they deem suspicious.

After reading this document you should be able to:

- Upload a paper using Turn-it-in
- View your originality report (dependent on the configuration of the assignment)
- 1. Your instructor will tell you where to look for the assignment, which will likely be in the same folder as other assignments. *Tii* assignment links feature the distinctive logo:





 In the ensuing interface enter your name, browse for the file you need to submit, and select
 Upload

> In most cases you will be uploading one document at a time, and the "enrolled student" option is a legacy of a past version of the product which can be ignored.

Files must be less than 20 MB and no more than 400 pages in length.

Acceptable file formats include:

- o MS Word
- o WordPerfect
- PostScript
- o PDF
- o HTML
- o RTF (rich text)
- o TXT (plain text)
