

## Teacher Professional Development in Sheltered English Instruction at WPU

2011-2012

This project is supported by NJ Department of Education for the purpose of providing professional development activities to assist K-12 classroom and content area teachers in acquiring knowledge and developing skills to work effectively with a linguistically and culturally diverse student body. 54 teachers from the northern New Jersey participated in intensive seminars on sheltered English instruction and learned effective ways to meet the unique needs of English language learners (ELLs). While the trained teachers actively implement sheltered English instruction, they also receive ongoing support by the trainers who will visit their classrooms and provide one-on-one feedback. In addition, participating teachers and administrators are invited to a follow-up workshop in March 30, 2012 and will learn how to turn key sheltered instruction strategies in their respective schools.
