During the last two weeks of the semester, candidates are in the field full-time.		*Students who were fully matriculated as education majors before August 31, 2014 must have and maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.75 in order to take education courses. As of September 1, 2016, a cumulative GPA of 3.0 will be required for certification. This means that students with a cumulative GPA of less than 3.0 must graduate and be recommended for certification before September 1, 2016.
