Projector Operations:

To begin, touch the touch screen. If it is currently black you will need to touch it twice.



The touch screen will now show a list of

> eight input options Desktop, Laptop, Blu-ray/DVD, and VHS on the left, and Document camera, Aux HDMI, Aux Vid, and blank on the right. Selecting any of these will lower the screen and turn on the projector.

- Volume can always be adjusted using the three bottom buttons to the right of the touch screen.
- When you are done, turn off the projector by touching the "shut down" button in the upper left of the touch screen.
- The touch screen will ask if you are sure you want to shut down. Touch the small red square that says "yes shut down", to shut down. If you are not done touch the large green square that says "do not shut down" to be returned to the main menu.

Laptop Operations:

- Connect a 15 pin VGA cable, and a sound cable from the laptop to the input located to the left of the touch screen. Cables can be borrowed from the Media Services desk in the library with a valid WPU ID.
- Turn on the projector. See projector op-٠ erations for further instructions.
- Turn on the laptop.



- If your laptop does not project properly, it may be necessary to change the display mode on the laptop. This can usually be accomplished by holding down Function, and pressing the key marked with a monitor symbol, or a square with a vertical line on either side.
- The Internet can be accessed by connecting an Ethernet ٠ cable from the laptop to the jack on the podium.

VCR Operations:

- Turn on the projector. See projector operations for instructions.
- Select VCR on the touch screen main menu.
- Once VCR has been selected, the controls to operate it will appear on the touch screen.

Blu-ray/DVD Operations:

- Turn on the Blu-ray/DVD/VCR unit, located in the front of the podium below the key board.
- Insert the Blu-ray • or DVD disk.

- Turn on the projector. See projector operations for further instructions.
- Select "Blu-ray" on the touch screen main menu.
- Once Blu-ray has been selected, the controls to operate it will appear on the touch screen.

Document Camera Operations:

- Pull open the drawer on the side of the podium to access the document camera.
- Lift up the arm of the document camera, and point the lens down toward the white area.
- Turn on the document camera.
 - Turn on the projector. See projector operations for further instructions.
- Select "Document Camera" on the touch screen main menu.
- Zoom and focus are located near the lens of the camera.
- When finished, please turn off the document camera, fold down the arm, and slide the drawer back into the podium.
