Review of charges:

Standing charges:

- 1) Develop standardized procedures for all campus-wide elections
- 2) Conduct Faculty Senate elections prior to April 30th
- 3) Conduct campus-wide elections according to the election policy for:
 - a) Promotion Committee, Sabbatical Leave Committee, Merit Award Committee.
 - b) University-wide ad-hoc Committees and major Search Committees

Additional Charges from the Executive Committee:

- 1) Review elections time line to consider a three week election period, instead of the current four week calendar.
- 2) Work with Human Resources to reestablish procedures for generating a list of eligible votes for each semester.
- 3) Consider whether two rounds of nominations in the election process are necessary.

Leadership:

Via email February 4th Obrecht volunteered to take over as Election Council Chair. Other election committee members were offered the chance to self-nominate, none of which did.

Additional Charges:

Charges 1 and 3:

The Council discussed changing to a three week election period by eliminating the second round of nominations. However, as Obrecht is a new chairperson and Cupo is new to this committee, we decided to hold off on a decision until the current Council has completed at least one election cycle.

Charge 2:

Human Resources was not able to generate a list of eligible voters. However, Neil Liggett/ from Enterprise Information Services will be able to assist with this process. Before an election the Council will need to submit a request via the WebHelpDesk

(https://help.wpunj.edu/helpdesk/WebObjects/Helpdesk.woa) listing the data required (i.e. first name, last name, ID number, department, college/division, building, office number, extension, email address, position type (facTeach, facLibrary, profStaff, adjunct), and tenure status). It would also be helpful to upload an example Excel file.

Spring 2016 Tasks:

The Council members volunteered to assist with the various tasks that need to be completed during Spring 2016 in order to successfully run both online and paper elections.
