

The William Paterson University Board of Trustees will establish new tuition/fee/room/board/related rates for the 2015-2016 academic year early July 2015. Final official tuition and fee rates for 2015-16 will be published on the William Paterson website at <http://www.wpunj.edu/studentaccounts/tuition-and-fees/>

Over the past several years, tuition rates have increased on average of 2.0% for students and meal plans are subject to increase per contractual agreement with our vendors. Residence Hall rates will remain at last years level. On the reverse side of this page there is a comparison of the current rates and *potential increases*, to assist in planning for next year. These are estimates and should be used solely as a guide. Official tuition billing statements will be available to students and their families mid-July 2015.

Utilize this guide and your financial aid award letter to determine likely out-of-pocket expenses for the Fall 2015 and Spring 2016 semesters.

William Paterson University will no longer directly offer health insurance to students. Due to recent legislature it is no longer a mandated requirement by the state of New Jersey for a student to have medical coverage in order to be enrolled at a state higher education institution. Dependents may be covered under their parent's insurance plan up to age 26. Any student who needs insurance may purchase their own policy and the federal health insurance exchange is a viable option and additional information may be found at www.healthcare.gov

William Paterson University offers ACTIVE ACCEPTANCE of Federal Direct Subsidized Loan or your Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan. This means that students will be required to log in to their WP Connect account to ACCEPT or Decline their Direct Student Loans. Students will be presented with three options: 1. Accept Full Awards, 2. Decline Awards, or 3. Accept Partial Awards. Please go to www.wpunj.edu/financial-aid/ for further details.
