First Time Freshmen: In addition to the above information, send your official high school transcript and S.A.T. / A.C.T. scores.

*All students must complete the Free Application for Federal Aid (FAFSA) for each academic year **by April 1**st. Students are also required to complete the Higher Education Student Assistance Authority (HESAA) form as soon as possible. If you do not adhere to the deadline, you may be ineligible for available federal and/or state financial aid programs for the **2014-2015 academic year**. The FAFSA can be obtained by contacting the federal processor at 1.800.433.3243 or going online at fafsa.ed.gov. We recommend that you use the **IRS Data Retrieval Tool**. It allows students and parents to access the IRS tax return information needed and transfer the data directly into their FAFSA. It's the best way of ensuring that your FAFSA has accurate tax information.
