*Students who place in Basic or Intermediate must take these courses before any other Spanish Major courses.*

*Students who place out of these courses either through the placement or challenge test can take major courses directly*

## I. CORE COURSES: 2000 LEVEL COURSES

- SPAN 2211 Gateway to Spanish Proficiency \*pre-req SPAN 2110, minimum grade D
- SPAN 2220 Advanced Spanish Composition
- SPAN 2290 Survey of Spanish Literature
- SPAN 2320 Survey of Latin American Literature
- SPAN 2500 Literary Analysis and Research Methods
- SPAN 4980 Spanish Capstone for Seniors

Students are required to complete Core Courses first (the 2000 level) before proceeding to II Electives and then III Seminars.

## II. ELECTIVES: 3000/4000 LEVEL COURSES

Take any 4 courses in the 3000 or 4000 level in the following areas: 2 courses from Latin America & 2 courses from Spain
