The Undergraduate Council approved and recommended to the Senate the following new programs during academic 2012-2013 school year:

1. Liberal Studies program change, to eliminate the interdisciplinary requirement.
2. A new B.A. in Computer Information Technology.

The Undergraduate Council also approved and recommended to the Senate the following changes to existing programs:

- (1) Proposal for French & Francophone studies to allow inclusion of Intermediate French I in the FFSP minor;
- (2) Proposal for French & Francophone studies to allow inclusion of Intermediate French II in the FFSP major.

The following programs are still under review with the Undergraduate Council:

- (1) Honors program in Business
- (2) BM in music sound engineering
