

Water Conservation at William Paterson University

- William Paterson University initiated a program to reduce the consumption of bottled water on campus through the installation of bottle filling stations.
- Nearly all bathrooms have motion-sensor operated faucets and 1.6 gpf toilets to reduce water waste.
- Only low-flow showerheads are installed in residence halls.
- All toilets on campus use reduced flow plumbing that reduces water consumption by more than 50%.
- Fields with irrigation systems are watered only once per week and only if there has been less than one inch of rainfall that week.
