

## Call for Participants

An extraordinary opportunity for education students to travel to Israel for a one month study abroad trip. All food, lodging, airfare, and ground transportation will be covered by the grant.



## Overseas Education Period: July 3 - August 1, 2017

All WPU education students with an interest in learning about the culture and history of Israel and the Near East region are encouraged to apply. Participants will also gain exposure to curriculum development for their future teaching. Applicants must have completed at least 24 credits at William Paterson University by December, 2016. Please submit the following documents via email: alons@wpunj.edu or fattall@wpunj.edu.

- A minimum cumulative undergraduate GPA: 3.0
- A 1–2 page essay on your interests and expectations from the project (Single spaced, 12 pt font).
- Two letters of recommendation from professors.
- Deadline for submission: December 15, 2016.
- Preference will be given to students who have not visited Israel before and who are interested in incorporating Israeli culture, history, social studies, and global understanding into their future instruction.
- Participants must be committed to attending all pre- and post-trip workshops and producing curriculum materials after the trip, to present and share with other students and teachers.
- Participants will be responsible for individual traveler's health insurance and personal expenses.
