- A one-page statement of your teaching philosophy (Single spaced, 12 pt font).
- A 1– 2 page essay on your interests and expectations from the project (Single spaced, 12 pt font).
- Two letters of recommendation.
- Deadline for submission: **December 15, 2016.**

- Preference will be given to those participants who have not visited Israel before and who are actively engaged in curriculum development that includes aspects of area studies, Near East history, and globalization, and who have an interest in teaching about Israel.

- Participants must be committed to attend all pre- and post-trip workshops and also produce curriculum materials after the trip to present and share with other students and teachers.

- Participants will be responsible for individual traveler's health insurance and personal expenses.
