

**Charges for the GE Council
for 2009-2010**

Standing Charges:

1. The General Education Council, working with the Undergraduate Council, shall monitor the General Education program and review and recommend to the Senate all proposed course and curriculum changes for General Education credit.
2. The General Education Council will review and make recommendations regarding all changes in the General Education Policy to the Senate.

Additional Charges for 2009-10:

1. Present two proposed GE curriculum models to the Senate no later than September 22, 2009.
2. Complete the model chosen by the Senate, or a composite model employing the two proposed model if the Senate so wishes, no later than November 10, 2009.
3. Gain Senate approval of a revised GE curriculum no later than December 2009.
4. Develop assessable learning objectives for the new curriculum no later than December 2009.
5. Work with the appropriate academic and administrative offices to establish the new GE curriculum as approved by the Senate.
6. Begin approving courses for the new curriculum in the Spring 2010 semester for implementation in the Fall 2011 semester.

Please keep minutes of each meeting and forward them, once approved, to the Vice Chair of the Senate for posting on the Council's page. Please follow the format which the Vice Chair will distribute to the Council at its first meeting. [Copies of the minutes for meetings held in 2008-2009, if available, would be appreciated.]

Please prepare an oral report, not to exceed 10 minutes, for the Senate meeting of Tuesday, March 23, 2010, on the Council's accomplishments for the year.

Please submit a written Year-End Report to the Vice Chair of the Senate no later than May 10, 2010. Please follow the format which the Vice Chair will distribute to the Council at its first meeting.
