Review of academic program changes from the College of Education	Three programs were presented and reviewed due to changes required by the New Jersey Dept. of Education: 1) Post Baccalaureate- P-3 Program – The curriculum was increased from 17 credits to 24 credits which included content and field hours. Suggestions were made to add a table of the new and revised courses for clarity. This program provides a pipeline for the master's program.
