 - e. Creative Expressions: Christine said that we try to include more events/sessions that present the creative expressions projects for next year's EXPLORATIONS. Angle said that she will announce it at the COAC college meeting.
 - f. The details of EXPLORATION2018 will be discussed at the first meeting of the next academic year.

- b. Standing charges: Lisa shared the Pam's email about the standing charges. The RSC members discussed whether or not the ART application and selection should be included in the Council's standing charges.
