EDUCATIONAL BENEFITS WORKSHOP REVIEW:

- REMEMBER TO FILL OUT FAFSA
- Any student that holds less than a 2.0 GPA for two consecutive semesters will not be eligible for educational benefits
- Hybrid courses are considered online

Iraq/ Afghanistan Waiver

- Any student who has a Global War on Terrorism Ribbon is eligible
- Waiver will cover tuition, student is responsible for fees
- If you are covered under the POST 9/11 and receive less then 100% you can use the wavier as well to cover the remaining balance of tuition.

Vocational Rehabilitation

- Goal of employing veterans
- Eligibility:20% or higher medical rating

Must show a need for degree

- Eligible for an additional 12 months of benefits
- Must have one (1) day left of post 9/11 to receive BAH
 Will cover 100% tuition and fees
- Can find application on VONAPP

3 week course - 2 credits

4 week course - 3 credits

6 week course - 4 credits

12 week course - 8 credits
