Online Course Content, Explainers and Practice – Sometimes it's helpful to see a topic reviewed step by step; get some additional explanations or practice problems when trying to learn more independently.

- **Khan Academy** – Video lessons and practice materials on a wide range of subjects – lessons are instructional and step by step for math, sciences, computer science, some humanities, economics and NCLEX or PRAXIS exam study.
