
How to Create a Testing Center Request

Step 2, Option 1:


HOVER your cursor over the Campus Life tab on the top of the page.

CLICK on *Accessibility Resource Center* under the Services option on the drop-down menu.



CLICK on WPconnect at the top of the screen.




CLICK on *Accessibility Resource Center* under the Resources to Help heading.
