- *Proof of bachelor's degree (copy of transcript or diploma), if other than from William Paterson University, is required.

POST-MASTER'S

- *A graduate student who has earned a master's degree and wishes to undertake further graduate study.
- *May take up to thirty (30) credits.
- *Proof of a master's degree (transcript or diploma), if other than from William Paterson University, is required.

VISITING

- *A matriculated graduate student at another college/university
- *An official permission letter from the dean of the home institution to take courses at William Paterson University is required.
- *May take only those courses specified in the letter.

PLEASE NOTE:

Admission into one of these categories does not imply eligibility for matriculation or acceptance into any degree or certification program.

Students in these categories are subject to the same academic standards and policies as matriculated students.

The applied clinical psychology and educational leadership programs are not open to nondegree students.

Courses in art, communication disorders, counseling, music, and nursing are only available to nondegree students with approval of the appropriate graduate program director.
