

Congratulations, you've been accepted to graduate studies!

Here are a few key steps to take on your path to enrolling in your graduate program.

1

Review your welcome email.

Your Welcome to William Paterson University email was sent to the email address that you provided on your application. Please take time to thoroughly review this information.

3

Get connected.

Activate your WP email account and your WP Connect account right away to ensure you are on track. The University sends all correspondence to this email address and the WP Connect portal allows you to access University resources along with your student records.

5

Review all financial information; apply for FAFSA; enroll in TIP plan.

The FSA ID: To be considered for most types of assistance, you must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). You need an FSA ID to electronically sign your FAFSA, make corrections to the application, and more. If you are a dependent student, your parent will need to create one as well. Create your FSA ID before you begin the FAFSA. William Paterson's code is: **002625** at fafsa.gov. You will need to complete your federal income tax information in order to complete the FAFSA. The Tuition Installment Plan (TIP) enables you to pay interest-free monthly installments on your account towards tuition, fee, and room and board expenses.

7

Apply for a WP parking permit.

Log into wpunj.edu/police/parking/. Register your vehicle online; permits will be mailed to you within a few days of registration.

2

Submit confirmation of acceptance.

Please click the link in your acceptance email to confirm your attendance.

4

Register for classes.

Log into WP Connect, select the Student tab on the top, then proceed to the My Registration tab. Select Add/Drop Courses. If you need assistance with course choices or course permits, please reach out to your program director.

6

Obtain your student ID.

After you have registered for classes you are eligible to obtain your student ID card. New students can obtain their ID cards via online photo submission from either a computer or smartphone. Please visit: wpunj.edu/id-cards for instructions.

Confer with your program director.

Get acquainted and meet with your program director. You will review your academic plans to ensure you stay on track and complete your studies on time.
