



#### Scholarship Award Criteria:


- Currently enrolled full-time students of an accredited NJ college or university
- Personal Statement: This statement must demonstrate your writing skills, personal strengths & goals, professionalism, financial need, community involvement, and other qualities you think we should know about you. Length of statement must be NO MORE THAN 500 words in English.
- Two Letters of Recommendation: At least one should be from a professor, teacher or a community leader.
- School Transcript: Must be in good academic standing and have a minimum cumulative weighted GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale (unofficial transcript is acceptable)
- Essay: No more than 500 words addressing **one** of the essay questions below.

#### **Essay Questions** (please choose one):

- 1. Write about a Latina in NJ known to the community (politics, education, business, etc.) who has influenced you and tell us why.
- 2. What type of policy issues do you see as being important to the Latino Community and how would you address these issues?
- 3. List extracurricular activities and any community service projects you have participated in within the past 2 years and tell us how they have made a difference in your community.

#### Applications are evaluated on the following criteria:

- Academic Achievement (including GPA, and past academic performance)
- Letters of Recommendation
- Personal and Essay Statements
- Complete application


