The Role of the Youth Program Student Assistant & Overnight Counselor

The role of the Student Assistant and Overnight Counselor is to help facilitate the learning process by mentoring and guiding the students, leading activities, and ensuring students are safe and compliant with the program rules and guidelines. This is an excellent opportunity to develop leadership skills, mentor middle and high school students, implement social programming, and build effective working relationships as you enjoy a fun and rewarding summer.

Job Responsibility include:

- Acting as mentor/role model to all summer youth programs participants
- Facilitating a welcoming environment to all youth programs participants and everyone they interact with during their role as a youth program team member
- Following check-in and check-out procedures of summer youth programs
- supervising students to-and-from classes, during meal times and activities throughout the day and/or evenings
- Working collaboratively and effectively in a team to ensure the safety of youth program students while on campus
- Assisting instructors in the classroom (Student Assistants only)
- Other duties as assigned

Important Information

Requirements:

In order to be considered for the 2018 Summer Youth Program Staff, you must be in:

- good standing with the University
- have/maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA.
- must have sophomore status or above.

Compensation information:

- Student Assistants are paid \$9 an hour and work an average of 15-39 hours a week. Hired Students Assistants are schedule to work the whole month of July 2018.
- Overnight Counselors are paid \$75 a night and will be on duty (4pm-9am) for 2 weeks on average in the month of July.

Candidates must be available to attend one of the following group Interview dates:

- Friday, April 20, 2018 from 12pm-2pm
- Monday, April 23, 2018 from 2pm-4pm
- Tuesday, April 24, 2018 from 10am-12pm
