# **SPRING 2017 SENATE ELECTIONS**

# To: Teaching & Library Faculty and Professional Staff

The Senate Elections Council is **now accepting withdrawals and optional biographical statements (150 words maximum)** from candidates for the Elections for the 2017-2018 Senate. The Elections are scheduled to run from Wednesday, April 12 to Wednesday, April 19 using a web based voting system, which will be available continuously during this period. Please see below for information on nominating and voting procedures. **All periods will start and end at noon.** 

- a. First round of nominations: March 21, 2017 to March 28, 2017
- b. Second round of nominations: March 28, 2017 to April 4, 2017
- c. Withdrawals and candidate biography submissions: April 4, 2017 to April 11, 2017
- d. Election: April 12, 2017 to April 19, 2017

### **General Information on Nominating and Voting:**

- 1. The first round of nominations will be accepted from **Tuesday, March 21 to Tuesday, March 28**. All nominations must be sent by email to senatevote@wpunj.edu and include:
  - a. Name of the nominee
  - b. Department of the nominee
  - c. Vacancy (Department or At-Large)
- 2. Self-nominations are acceptable. If making a third-party nomination, please CC the person you are nominating when submitting.
- 3. Nominees will receive an email from <a href="mailto:senatevote@wpunj.edu">senatevote@wpunj.edu</a> confirming receipt of the nomination.
- 4. Based upon the results of the first round of nominations, a preliminary list of candidates will be announced on **Tuesday**, **March 28**. This list will also constitute the beginning of the second round of nominations. During the second round, nominations will be accepted until **noon on Tuesday**, **April 4**. Nominees must contact the Senate Elections Council by email at <a href="mailto:senatevote@wpunj.edu">senatevote@wpunj.edu</a> to confirm acceptance of nomination by **noon on Tuesday**, **April 4**.
- 5. Based upon the results of the second round of nominations, a list of candidates will be announced on **Tuesday**, **April 4**. This list will also constitute the beginning of the Withdrawal period. Withdrawals and candidates' optional biographical statements (150 words maximum) will be accepted **until noon on Tuesday**, **April 11**. Withdrawals and candidate biographies must be sent by email to <a href="mailto:senatevote@wpunj.edu">senatevote@wpunj.edu</a>.
- 6. All email correspondence regarding nominations, acceptances, withdrawals, and biographies will be confirmed via <a href="mailto:senatevote@wpunj.edu">senatevote@wpunj.edu</a>.
- 7. A final list of candidates will be announced on **Tuesday, April 11**. Elections will be held from **Wednesday, April 12 at noon to Wednesday, April 19 at noon**. No write-in candidates will be accepted.
- 8. Any unopposed candidates will automatically be declared as elected.

#### **Senate Vacancies:**

Vacancies open for nomination and election are listed below. All those seats with a term ending in 2017 are up for vote.

- 1. Current Senate members and their terms are listed below.
- 2. All full-time teaching & library faculty and professional staff are eligible to nominate and vote, but only for vacancies in their own constituencies. Only faculty members in departments listed below may nominate and vote for representatives in these departments. Only library faculty may nominate and vote for a library representative. Only professional staff may nominate and vote for a professional staff representative.
- 3. All full-time teaching & library faculty and professional staff may nominate and vote for up to 4 At-Large representatives.
- 4. Tenure is not required for either the nominee or the nominator in the Senate election.
- 5. The newly elected members of the Senate shall serve a 2 year term and assume their office at the first meeting of the New Senate on **May 4, 2017**.
