Dear Student/Faculty/Staff Member:

In anticipation of your arrival to the University, we are providing you with the enclosed parking permit/decal along with important information regarding parking and transportation on campus.

Surface lot parking is available at no charge to any student, faculty or staff member. On the main campus (Lots 1, 2, 4, 5 and 6), designated resident and commuter student parking areas are identified by white lines. Faculty/staff designated parking areas are identified by yellow lines, including Lot 8, at Hobart Hall. Evening classes after 7:00pm, students may park in the faculty/staff parking areas of Lot 3.

Handicapped parking is available in all lots except Lots 1 and 2. Vehicles must have handicapped license plates or official hangtags displayed to utilize those spaces.

**Resident Student** parking is available in specific lots, which are adjacent to the residence halls. Resident parking is available in Lot 1, Lot 2 rows C and D, Lot 6 and lots near Pioneer and Heritage Residence Halls. Overnight parking is only permitted in those lots, and vehicles parked in those lots must display a resident parking permit/decal.

Pioneer Parking is available to any student, faculty or staff member who pays for a garage parking rate plan or on an hourly rate basis. Garage parking is available 24 hours a day, every day. Overnight parking is available to resident students who pay for a residential rate plan. Parking fees at the garage are dependent upon the status of the person parking and upon the amount of time the person parks in the garage. The four rate plans are as follows:

- a. Hourly
- b. Commuter student
- c. Resident student
- d. Faculty and staff

**Students** – Pioneer Garage rate plan fees are payable through WP Connect by clicking on the Student Tab, then *General Services* and the *Pioneer Parking Garage Sign Up*. Students can select the semester or academic year rate plan. The chosen plan will be billed to your student account.

**Faculty & Staff** – Pioneer Garage rate plan fees are payable through WP Connect by clicking on the Employee tab and then *My HR & Payroll Forms* and then *Pioneer Express/Pioneer Parking Garage*.

**Parking permits/decals must be displayed** and affixed to your driver's side back passenger window. Any vehicle not displaying a permit/decal is subject to fines and/or towing.

**Shuttle Service** transportation is provided to the University community including travel to 1600 Valley Road, Power Arts and College Hall. **Safe Ride** is also available for transportation every twenty minutes from Lot 1, Lot 5, Lot 6, Tower's Circle, Heritage and Pioneer Hall between 11:00pm and 3:00am, Sunday through Saturday. **Safe Walk** is a service provided to students, faculty and staff in which Student Patrol accompanies you to your destination during specific hours. It is a supplement to the shuttle service.
