Maximizing Access to Research Careers for Undergraduate – Student Training in Academic Research (MARC U-STAR) Program from the National Institutes of Health

A Grants Resource Center webinar offered by the Office of Sponsored Programs

The Office of Sponsored Programs (OSP) invites you to participate in a webinar offered by the Grants Resource Center. This is the second of three webinars to be offered during August and September 2016.

MARC U-STAR is an institutional research training program for honors junior and senior level undergraduate students. It is designed to provide structured training programs to prepare high-achieving, underrepresented students for doctoral programs in biomedical research fields. Programmatic activities include authentic research experiences, academic enhancements, skills development, and mentoring. In FY15, NIGMS supported 53 institutions and 553 trainees. The presenters will be Alison Gammie, Sailaja Koduri, and Richard Okita, from the National Institute of General Medical Sciences (NIGMS), National Institutes of Health. During the webinar, the presenters as well as and currently funded principal investigators will describe successful programs and offer proposal preparation tips.
