About the play:

Alan Zuckerman has compiled a list of events that numbers 997 regarding his three-year old son David. A list with specific documentation that he believes proves that David is the Messiah. Yes, THAT Messiah! And he has brought the list, David and his 'in-the-dark' wife to their Rabbi for verification. Skepticism abounds in this new comedy drama that explores the expectations we put on others to "do good" and have for ourselves.

About the characters (3 Men, 1 Woman):

Male, early 30s - Plays Gary Gerber in Act 1, a Rabbi. Plays David Gerber in Act 2, Gary's son married to David Zuckerman. Both are Jewish.

Male, early 30s - Plays Alan Zuckerman in Act 1. Plays David Zuckerman in Act 2, Alan's son married to David Gerber. Both are Jewish.

Female, early 30s - Plays Laura Zuckerman in Act 1, the wife of Alan Zuckerman. Plays Beth Zuckerman in Act 2, the sister to David Zuckerman. Both are 8 months pregnant.

Male, early 60s - Plays Gary Gerber in Act 2 - now older, still a Rabbi, still Jewish.
