Howard Honigfeld Scholarship Fund Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

Four scholarships will be awarded annually in the amount of \$2,500 each for the college education of a cancer survivor. Recipients are selected by a committee of judges appointed by The Fighting Children's Cancer Foundation. Their award decisions are final.

To be eligible, an applicant must satisfy all the following requirements:

- The applicant must be a cancer survivor.
- The applicant must be graduating from high school by June 2012 or currently enrolled in college working towards their undergraduate degree.
- The applicant must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 and must provide transcript from high school.
- The applicant must complete the Scholarship Application.
- The applicant must submit one letter of recommendation from an academic teacher .
- A letter from your attending physician verifying your medical history and current medical situation must be submitted. Medical information will be kept confidential and will only be utilized to support the qualification of consideration for the scholarship.
- The applicant must submit a one page essay discussing the following question. HOW HAS MY EXPERIENCE WITH CANCER IMPACTED BY LIFE VALUES?
- The applicants and their parents, if they are minors, must sign a release, that they agree to have their name and photo published in the news media or any FCCF publication as a recipient of the Howard Honigfeld Scholarship Fund and they agree to have their name, photo and success story to be published on the FCCF website or in any FCCF publication.
- All of the above must be received by February 28, 2012 and all winners will be notified by March 9, 2012. All winners are encouraged to attend the FCCF Dinner Dance on March 24, 2012. All winners will be recognized at the dinner.
