- Vision and voice that impacts lives and the welfare of the community

Important information for nominators and nominees:

Nominations will be considered regardless of race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, age, marital status, familial status, or affectional or sexual orientation. Nominations cannot be considered for posthumous awards. Our award is open to women in all fields and endeavors, at any stage of their careers.
