## Using the SafeAssign anti-plagiarism tool

We are testing SafeAssign as a replacement for Turn-it-in. I've posted the Blackboard documentation for this tool, but if you find that Blackboard documents can confuse more than they clarify this document is for you.

## Set up a SafeAssign assignment

1. When creating the assignment (or using Edit in an existing assignment) select Submission Details [1].

2-3. In the *Plagiarism Tools* area select the Check Submissions box. The second option, Allow Students to View the SafeAssign Originality Report is the choice of each instructor. The third option asks the instructor whether or not to include the document in the system database. Not including each assignment would have the effect of weakening the tool but again, the choice is up to each instructor.

5. And because this paper is indeed heavily plagiarized the score is 100%:
