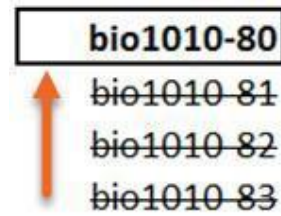
This document will help faculty 1. Distinguish between merge and master, 2. Submit a request for either option

1. Merge and Master

Merge

- Students from the client sections -81, -82 & -83 are **diverted** to the *parent* section-80.
- Client sections are *inactive and are unavailable* to students. All course activity takes place in the parent shell.

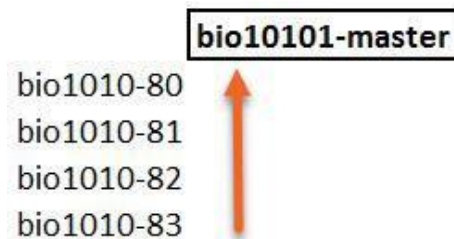
Merge is a good option for a multi-section courses taught by a single instructor



Master

- Students from client shells are added to a master section. The master section exists apart from the shells from which the students are drawn.
- The client course shells are autonomous and can be used to host content and interaction apart from that which takes place in the master shell

Master is appropriate for lecture/lab courses



2. Request

- The form-based request too has been eliminated
