To assist students with completing their GREEK STARS Badge, the Office of Campus Activities, Service and Leadership, has created these on-line leadership development options. These are for students that need to complete the "Leadership Development" requirements listed below.

Remote Learning Opportunities and Process:

Below we have identified several Greek Leadership development talks / webinars aimed at increasing personal leadership and group dynamics to assist you with becoming a confident and inclusive Greek leader:

- Students who need to complete workshops can view <u>THREE</u> videos to complete their badge. At the end of each video, download and complete the Greek STARS Remote Learning Assessment Form.
- Students who need to complete a civic engagement experience can view a video and submit an assessment, or participate in a virtual civic engagement experience and submit the required documentation.
- Submit the completed assessment form(s) to Tristan Tosh at tosht@wpun.edu or Myranda Barreau at barreaum@wpunj.edu within one week of viewing the video.
- CASL staff will update your path / badge progress on Pioneer Life on your Engagement Portfolio. Note that all Remote Learning Opportunities must be submitted by May 1, 2020 to be considered for completion of the GREEK STARS Badge for induction into the WP LEADS 2020 Honor Society.

- 1. <u>Attendance at Hazing Prevention Presentation</u> (80% of Each Chapter) This must have been completed during the year. If you believe you have fulfilled this requirement, please indicate that on the LEADS Honor Society application.

Low Level Civic Engagement

There are two options for completing a low level civic engagement experience:

- Students may complete one virtual civic engagement activity. Offerings available are on https://wpunj.campuslabs.com/engage/. In order to receive a low level civic engagement credit, students must submit a photo of your service (i.e. dropping off donations, making pet toys, etc.), a brief description of the activity, and the organization / group receiving the donations.
- 2. **Students may view one civic engagement video,** and submit a completed assessment form to receive low level civic engagement credit for watching video. Download and complete the form on the CASL webpage
