1. Students who transfer from a community college with an Associate in Applied Science (AAS) degree or a Certificate, will have their credits evaluated on an individual course basis. William Paterson University general education or university core curriculum (UCC) credits are not waived for transfer students holding AAS degrees. WP will accept 25 credits from ECC's curriculum toward WP's general education requirement; students transferring to WP must complete two additional UCC courses to fulfill the requirement of 30 general education credits. Students transferring to WP in this pathway should take one course from UCC area C, H or I, and one course from K, L, M, or N.
2. William Paterson University recommends students to take two semesters of one world language at the community college. Two semesters of American Sign Language can also fulfill the world language requirement.
3. WP Online students should always check with their WP Online advisor and/or refer to the semester course schedule when choosing electives, as elective course offerings may vary each semester.
