Iman Boukadoum is an Algerian-American, Muslim social justice attorney. Her career began at the **Office for Civil Rights and Civil Liberties** at the **Department of Homeland Security** in Washington D.C. Next she worked at the Center for Justice of the **American Civil Liberties Union**, addressing the issue of the militarization of policing, resulting in the report *War Comes Home* published right before the 2014 Ferguson, Missouri, protests. She then joined the **law firm** of Youman, Madeo and Fasano, dealing with asylum and immigration

cases. She is now the **Director of Community Partnerships at the Interfaith Center of New York**, an organization that supports grassroots, interfaith campaigns on social justice issues, while combating bigotry and misunderstanding.
