Submit Application Online Common App or Private App



Request official documentation to be sent electronically

We're test-optional for all majors, including meritbased scholarship consideration.



- Essay/Personal Statement/Recommendation Letters are optional
- Application fee is waived by campus visit (in-person or virtual)



Post-Application



Application Acknowledgement Email

- 2-3 business days after submission
- Has student's ID and next steps to complete application



Documents take up to two weeks to be posted to the student's application after received

Who can apply to the Honors college?

-Most accepted students have taken multiple honors, dual-enrollment, or AP courses in their high school careers. Also, if you have ever received any academic awards while participating in any extracurricular interests.

(Essay quality and content are very important.)

• Test scores are optional for freshmen applicants. PSATs may be submitted instead. If no test scores are available, a secondary essay will be required






Pledge 4 Success
