Parents play a crucial role in the success of our accepted students.

Here's your student's enrollment checklist to ensure they stay on track:

1 Learn about New Student Orientation and pre-packaged course schedules.

Once your student submits their enrollment deposit and completes their placement exam, they'll receive email and mail from Student Development regarding New Student Orientation. wpunj.edu/orientation

- **DID YOU KNOW?** Class schedules are pre-packaged for your student's first and second semesters and will be viewable within WPCconnect once prepared.
- During the first semester, your student will learn more about their personalized Student Success Team, which includes their professional advisor, a financial aid counselor, and a career coach, among others.
- All coursework will be graduation requirements, including one signature course, Will. Power. 101, which is designed to support first-year students as they transition to University expectations and skills in three areas: academics, community engagement, and personal development. wpunj.edu/wp101

2 Apply for Financial Aid.

Complete the FAFSA. (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) at studentaid.gov. WP's code is **002625**

3 Go to WPCconnect and check email.

Student's should log in to **WPCconnect** (student portal) to stay on track and activate/access **their** student email.

4 Take placement exam.

After your student submits their non-refundable, non-transferable \$125 enrollment deposit, they will receive mail and email from the **Office of Testing** in regards to their placement exam.

5 Visit the Health Portal.

Submit required immunization forms through the **Student Health Portal**

6 Review Medical Insurance Requirements.

Students are required by state law to have appropriate medical insurance.

As a full-time student, students are automatically enrolled in Aetna Student Health.

This plan is billed annually (or pro-rated for spring admits) to the student's account.
