



This community is geared towards career exploration and personal reflection, and will help you learn more about who you are and discover career paths that are fit for you.





The Degree consists of 120 credits total:

- **University Core Curriculum (40 credits)**
- **Major requirements (60 – 69 credits)**
- **World language requirement (can be waived)**
- **4 Writing-Intensive courses (can double-count)**
- **2 Technology-Intensive courses (can double-count)**

Transfers on course-by-course basis

Some students choose to **double major, add a **minor**, or join the **honors track** to reach 120 credits.**

Degree Requirements for Transfer Students *with* Completed AA/AS

The Degree consists of 120 credits total:

- Major requirements (60 – 69 credits)
- World language requirement (can be waived)
- 1 Writing-Intensive course 3000/4000 level (can double-count)
- Prerequisites for major courses

Some students choose to **double major**, add a **minor**, or join the **honors track** to reach 120 credits.


