- Students are in contact with family members at least 10-14 times a week on average (Hofer and Moore, 2010, pg. 20)
- According to a 2016 research conducted by CampusESP, student persistence can increase with parent engagement by up to 15%
- In the Fall 2020, CampusESP found that student retention is 8% higher when families are engaged and involved
- 75% of students frequently follow advise from a parent or guardian (Sax and Wartman, 2010, pg. 243)
