#### Introduction



## Step 1: Find a Contest

This year, there are **three** regional contests leading up **one** state contest. You can sign up for one contest, or as many as you wish.




- Saturday, February 28, 2026: Regional Contest at Monmouth University (Metro Region)
- Saturday, March 7, 2026: Regional Contest at Rutgers-Camden University (Southern/Central Region
- Saturday, March 21, 2026: Regional Contest at St. Elizabeth's University (Northern Region)
- Saturday, May 2, 2026 : State Contest at William Paterson University

### Step 2: Go to your contest website



Each contest has its own **zFairs** website. Copy or click on the links to go directly to the site for that contest.



#### Step 3: Create an account




Enter your name and email in the "Sign-Up Now" box.



If you are an NJHD teacher who will also judge, use a different email address than the one you registered with as a teacher.


### Step 4: Select your "Register As" role

Where you see "Register As," use the drop-down menu to select the role "Judge."



#### Step 5: Verify your email

The next screen will ask you to return to your email inbox and click a link to verify your email address.







If you don't see the email, check your SPAM filter, trash, and other folders.

#### Step 6: Complete your profile

- Choose an easy-to-remember password. If you ever forget it, click the blue word "Help" on the login page to reset.
- Fill out the form with your contact information.



#### Step 7: Select your judging preferences



The next page asks about which entry categories you would like to judge.

**Virtual Judging**: Papers and Websites are judged virtually starting two weeks before the contest. Select this category if you want to judge entirely online from home.

**In-Person Judging:** Documentaries, Exhibits, and Performances are only judged in person on the day of the contest. Select these categories if you plan to join us in person on contest day, from 8 AM to 3 PM.


Most categories have both **Individual** and **Group** divisions. You can select your preference. The Paper category has only individual entries.

Finally, agree to the Conflict of Interest statement.

#### Step 8: Answer a few additional questions

The next page asks about your background and how you heard about the contest. Please enter a short response that will help us match you with a judge team and category.

If there is anything else you would like us to know, such as a potential conflict of interest, you can enter that info here.




#### Step 9: Read the fine print

#### Step 10: You're Done!




The final screen will show your full name, username, and password. Take a screenshot so you'll have it handy if you need it again.


#### Registering for Multiple Contests

#### Registering for Multiple Contests






