- Many of the events are offered in partnership with offices of which commuters may not be aware.

10:23 a.m. An Introduction to the Academic Development Team

Associate Provost Danielle Liataud-Watkins introduced the team members and spoke about the mission of this reorganization to develop a trusting relationship with students which had led to small gains in first year retention.

- New Student Experience Director Dr. Kim Daniel-Robinson provided the following goals:
  - Provide a transition from high school to WPU
  - Collaborate with all aspects of the University
  - Promote tutoring and advising
  - Oversight for the Pioneer Success Seminar with Peer Leaders and instructors from across the University
- Transfer Student Experience Director Amanda Vasquez gave the following overview:
  - The office is unique to WPU due to our student demographic
  - Programs (about 15 each semester) are crafted in partnership with academics
  - Serve as advisors and also work with re-admitted students
  - Oversight for a peer to peer program, transfer student club and transfer student honor society
- Sophomore & Junior Year Experience Director Jonnine Deloatch stated her office supports the middle years of the college experience:
  - Assist students in finding their identity through majors, fit within the University and connection to the larger community
  - Also provides opportunities for students to develop emotional intelligence and become a global citizen

- First Year Foundations Director Linda Refsland spoke about working with students to meet math, reading and writing requirements:
  - One half of the entering class works with the Foundations Summer Program, which is free and includes books
  - Also works with students on academic probation each spring
  - Practices intrusive outreach and secondary advisement as well as academic coaching
- Academic Success Center Director Rogernelle Griffin shared that her office teaches students to learn how to learn:
  - Provides basic tutoring and supplemental instruction
  - Support for all courses in the Humanities, Sciences and Math; recently increased offerings for graduate students
  - Early Alert is currently being revised into Progress Reports via the starfish platform. More information will be available once the development is complete.
