STUDY ABROAD PROGRAM



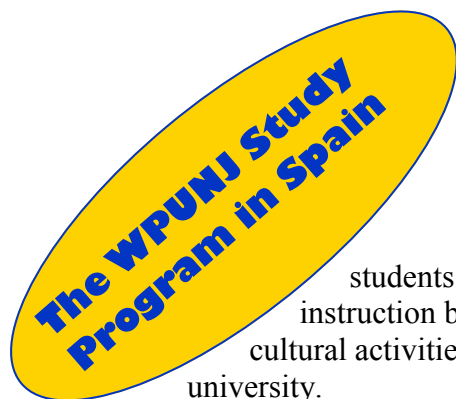

Is designed to provide students with language and cultural instruction by immersion in the everyday life and cultural activities of a typical Spanish university.

THE PROGRAM

The SAP-Spain will start with a week stay in Barcelona and trips to Girona and Zaragoza. We will also visit Nuestra Señora del Pilar in Zaragoza. In Madrid we will visit Prado Museum, Thyssen-Bornemisza, Reina Sofia Museum and Toledo and El Greco Museum.

After the first week, Students will travel to the University of Santiago de Compostela where they will take courses for 4 weeks.

The courses in Spanish culture, taught by WPU faculty, will incorporate field trips relevant to the subjects studied. Language instruction will be provided by the host University within its already well-established Summer Program.

FACULTY

Dr. Octavio de la Suarée will be teaching the culture course along with faculty on site.

WHO MAY APPLY

The SAP-Spain is open to all students in good academic standing.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Students will fill out the preliminary application form on this brochure and will turn it to :

Lorraine Caruso, in Atrium 239,

by February 14th, 2011. Early applications are encouraged since space is limited and it will be given on a first come first serve basis.

A committee formed by faculty from the Department of Languages and Cultures will screen the applicants and choose a pool, with a list of alternates if the pool is too large. Three mandatory orientation meetings for successful applicants will be held during Spring semester to go over details of the SAP in Spain and to provide materials that will help prepare students for the Spanish experience.

COST*- \$ 4, 499.00

*Might be subject to slight changes depending on Euro-Dollar exchange rate.

Includes: Airfare, Stay in Madrid, and Barcelona 6 credits transferred from Santiago de Compostela, health insurance, tuition at the University of Santiago de Compostela, residency (individual dorm room with bathroom), 3 meals per day (weekdays in Santiago de Compostela), books and school supplies, admission to museums, and fieldtrips.

Does not include WPUNJ tuition (6 credits) * you must register in summer 2, 2011 for Spanish 303.

Once accepted to the SAP-Spain, each student will be individually advised about what courses to register for.
