**Sheila Y. Oliver (D), Speaker of the House, New Jersey General Assembly**

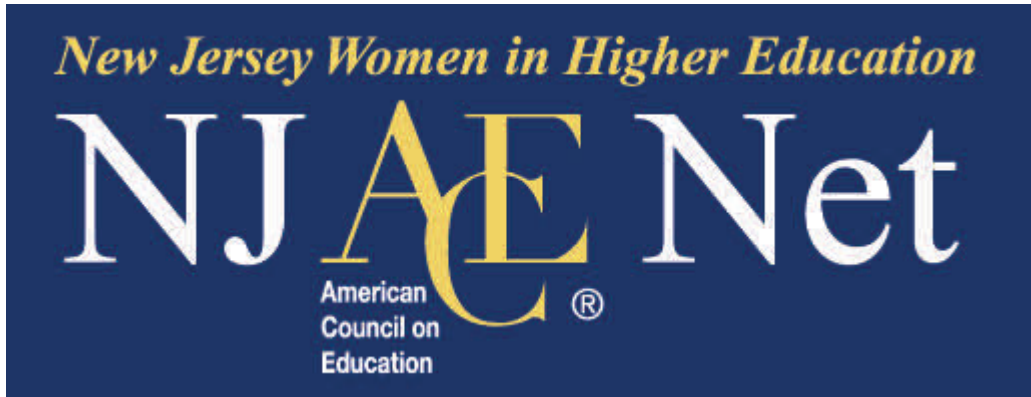
Sheila Y. Oliver, who was first elected to the Assembly in 2003, took the oath of office as New Jersey's 169th Assembly Speaker on Jan. 12, 2010. Speaker Oliver is the first African-American woman to lead a legislative house in New Jersey. She is also, according to the National Conference of State Legislatures, just the second African-American woman in American history to lead a legislative house. In the 2008-09 Legislative Session she served as Deputy Speaker Pro Tempore and served as Assistant Majority Leader in the 2006-07 Legislative Session. She represents the 34th Legislative District. Speaker Oliver graduated cum laude with a Bachelor's degree in sociology from Lincoln University in Pennsylvania. She has also earned a Master of Science degree in community organization, planning and administration from Columbia University.

**Susan Shin Angulo, Assembly woman, Cherry Hill Twshp.**



Susan Shin Angulo is the first Korean-American woman elected to office in New Jersey. She is a dedicated community volunteer and activist who has given her time to the Cherry Hill Zoning Board of Adjustment, the Human Relations Council, and the Food Bank of South Jersey. She holds a Bachelor's degree in Biology from Wilkes University and a Post Baccalaureate in Cytogenetics from Thomas Jefferson University. Professionally, Councilwoman Angulo has extensive experience in pharmaceutical and biotech marketing, as well as real estate management.
